MOTORCYCLE SAFETY TIPS FOR RIDING WITH A CO-RIDER

TRUST YOUR CO-RIDER

Riding with someone is like building a relationship—they both require trust.



Make sure your co-rider has the appropriate gear including a helmet.

Teach your co-rider how to mount and dismount properly.



Tell your co-rider to communicate with you.

Develop signals for caution or use intercoms to talk.



Your co-rider should pretend as if she is part of the motorcycle. Have the co-rider look over your shoulder in the direction of the turn for proper leaning, and when braking, hold tight to avoid bumping helmets.

YOUR CO-RIDER MUST TRUST YOU

Equal trust will allow for an enjoyable ride.
